Students enrolled in the Rehabilitation Aide program at EHS will learn all the necessary skills to enter the field of Sports Medicine. Students will learn how to take vital signs (blood pressure, pulse, respirations), and height and weight.

They will also learn skills such as taping, wrapping, splinting, bracing, and injury prevention, rehab, assessment, and treatment. Students will earn basic anatomy and physiology and medical terminology.

Students will participate in a "field experience" with EHS sports. They will attend games and practices and shadow the athletic trainer all while having the best seat in the house for the events; on the sidelines!
